

'Parts List

Equipment Required:

- Interlocking Porcine Model (preferably)
- Desk or Table
- Appropriate needle for blood sampling
- We recommend using q 19-21 gauge needle that is 3.5" long
- Holsim Blood Pump
- Holsim Artificial Blood

You will need:


- Jugular block with connectors
- knurl screw
- Holsim Blood pump




The Parts





The Process




1 Connect Blood pump

- Connect the blood pump tubing to each end of the jugular vein connectors.
- Ensure tubing is pushed on tightly



2 Set up the blood pump

- Unscrew the lid and pour the Holsim artificial blood into the Holsim blood pump jar with tubing.
- Replace lid tighten



3 Switch pump on

- Switch the blood pump on
- The blood should slowly pulse through the tubing into the jugular vein and back round into the jar.



4 Palpate the vein

- Palpate the jugular vein by finding the hollow groove in the neck. This is where the jugular vein runs.
- It should feel nice and soft.



5 Insert the needle

 The need should be inserted perpendicular to the skin at the deepest point of the jugular groove.

The Clean Up




5 Undo jar lid

 Once the blood sample has been obtained undo the jar lid with the pump connectors on it and hold the tubes above the blood in the jar.



6 Drain tubing

 With the jar tubing out of the blood, the pump will pulse the remaining blood in the tubes into the jar, without sucking any more blood up.



Turn pump off

 Once all the blood has been drained from the tubing, switch the pump off



Flush tubing with water

- It is best to flush the tubing out with water to have them clean before storing the pump.
- You can do this by replacing the jar of blood with one of water. Turn the pump on to flush the tubing vein.



9 Disconnect pump

- Once clean, turn the pump off
- Disconnect the blood pump tubing from the jugular vein connectors.



10 Remove jugular and stone

- Wipe any blood from the surface of the skin and allow tubing to dry.
- Store jugular block and blood pump in a airtight container.
